Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Penshurst West Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Penshurst West Public School. The project will deliver seven innovative learning spaces in a new building, new student amenities, and a special programs room.

Progress summary

The school upgrade is progressing well with main works for the new building underway. Foundation and structural works have commenced with the installation of the ground floor slab.

Next steps

Building works will continue during the September school holidays with the installation of steel work, brick work and site services ongoing.
