Our sport representatives for hockey, touch football and basketball all competed in the first round of the season during the last week of term 3.


Some of our hockey players participated in a Gala Day at Sylvania recently which was a great experience. Watch out for coming PSSA updates in the next newsletter.

# 2017 Selective High School Applications

This notice is for this years, Year 5 students wishing to apply for a selective school for year 7 2017.

Applications will open online on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2015 and will close on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2016. Applications can only be made online through this website www.schools.nsw.edu.au/shsplacement The Selective High Schools test will be sat on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2016.

There are 47 selective high schools in NSW consisting of 17 fully selective, 25 high schools with selective classes and 4 Agricultural high schools. 33 of these classes are in metropolitan Sydney.

### Cyber-bullying

It is an unfortunate that a fact of our society that bullying has become prevalent in all our interactions.
