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From The Principal's Desk

Welcome back to the final term of 2016. It is going to be one that will be busy, filled with the celebration of achievements and the end to a group of students who have spent upward of seven years at Penshurst West Public School.

Over the next few weeks we have the mobile Dental Clinic (W3), our School Concert on Thursday 10 November (W5) and the Stage 3 Camp (W6). We already have a great deal to look forward to.

In this Newsletter I am seeking your feedback through a survey on the extra programs that we have implemented this year to help organise programs for 2017. Please take the time to send this survey back. A small number of families have provided their thoughts through the *Tell Them From Me* survey. But as we only had 20 responses from over 200 families it does not provide enough information as to which programs you felt were beneficial for your children.

High School Students Collecting Siblings

Last term the school requested that high school students remain outside of the school gates when collecting their siblings. This was as a result of a number of high school students being in the vicinity of the senior classrooms and swearing, disturbing the students and generally being disrespectful to the teachers and classes. Over the years there have been similar issues where groups of high school students are on the grounds for more than 40 minutes before our school finishes.

At Penshurst West PS we wish to provide the best possible learning environment for our students but also recognise the need for some high school students to collect their siblings in the afternoon. I would like to welcome back those students and acknowledge the parent support that has been given.

The high school students are welcome to wait in the lower playground around the Hall and Canteen. This will allow them to easily find their family members but not disrupt the learning of our students.

Enrolments in 2017

Currently the school has 31 Kindergarten students for next year. This is a decrease in the enrolment numbers from the past few years but we believe there are still some families who are yet to enrol. If you know of any families who are planning to come to Penshurst West Public School next year, please ask them to complete an enrolment form. The Kindergarten Orientation Program is being held on Wednesday 16, 23, and 30 November.

We also have a number of families each year who move away from the area. If you know that you will be moving and not returning to Penshurst West Public

School in 2017, please let the Office know as this will also affect the number of classes. Your help in these areas is greatly appreciated.


