Social Media

We have been experiencing issues with students on social media. Although some of the issues are arising in Stage 3, the majority are coming from students in Stage 2.

Class teachers have talked extensively to their students about the potential dangers of social media. The inappropriateness of some of the conversations that have been occurring online and the age restrictions of the sites suggests that none of the Years 3 and 4 students should be using the apps.

There is some cyber bullying occurring which will not be tolerated at Penshurst West. But it is also concerning to have noted that students are creating an

unsafe environment for themselves by publicly posting their name, school and displaying photos in their school uniform on their social media accounts.

I am asking for parents to be vigilant with their children's activity on social media apps and not simply believe what their child is telling them. Please take a moment to check the security settings of your child's account and monitor the time that they are on their devices. The teachers at school have found that several students are using social media apps between midnight and 2 am.

Your support in this area is crucial.


















The Schools Spectacular


