COVID RESTRICTIONS UPDATE

It brings such joy to be able to welcome parents back on site!! You may have seen in communications sent out recently that as of this week parents are welcome to come onsite, drop off and pick up their children. Please feel welcome to take this opportunity to have a chat with other parents and reunite with everyone.

We are busily planning some activities for you to share with us and hopefully life will begin to return to 'normal'.

Here is a reminder of the changes

From Monday 28 February 2022

- Cohorting no longer required: Students will no longer be required to be kept in year groups or other cohorts. This means schools can remove staggered start and finish times as well as reintroduce cross-year group activities and events such as assemblies. Schools should continue to apply the layered COVID-smart measures for minimising risk when planning activities and events.
- Visitors allowed on school sites Schools can invite visitors including parents, carers and families – onto school sites regardless of their vaccination status to allow greater community engagement. Schools should continue to apply the layered COVID-smart measures for minimising risk when inviting visitors to come on site.
- Rapid antigen testing moving to 'symptomatic testing' only. Schools have provided a final
 allocation of 8 tests to support this for the remainder of term (20 for students and staff in
 SSPs and support classes). After this bundle, symptomatic students and staff should resume
 PCR testing or use their own home RAT kits, which are now readily available and accessible
 in the community.

From Monday 7 March 2022

Masks will no longer be mandatory in primary schools for staff and will no longer be
provided. This staggered change recognises the lower vaccination rates in primary schoolaged students. Anyone still wishing to wear a masks is very welcome to do so.
